Named as one of New Zealand's Top 10 wineries in Decanter Magazine. Trinity Hill has gained a worldwide reputation for its wines, especially the reds from its Gimblett Gravels estate. The Homage Syrah was the first New Zealand red to reach a stunning 95 points.
